On the **NDOT Financial Reports** page:

- Scroll ½ way down to bold header, **City/County Information**
- Under **Highway User Revenue Distribution** header:
 - **County** (pages 4-7) collection of data is: July 1, 20__ thru June 30, 20__.
 - **Municipal** (page 8 +) collection of data is: Oct 1, 20__ thru Sept 30, 20__.
- Watch the headers on each page as they change.
 - *Build Nebraska Act funds are included in the Highway Allocation amount.*
- **Introduction** (page 2, 1st paragraph) **identifies year of revenue** amount.
- **Fiscal Year date range** (page 4), upper right-hand corner) is noted.

Projected Highway User Revenue Distribution

To view the **Projected Highway User Revenue Distributions** for the **next** fiscal year:

- On **NDOT Financial Reports** page,
- **City & County Projection Books** (bookmark <https://dot.nebraska.gov/business-center/financial-reports/>)
- Click on applicable year.
