

NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

N-1 - Louisville

STP-50-2(139); C.N. 22803

Identified as **N-1 - Louisville**, this project would improve approximately 6.04 miles of Nebraska Highway 50 (N-50) and 0.50 miles of Nebraska Spur 13F (S-13F) in Cass County.

The proposed work on N-50 would begin approximately 0.08 miles north of the junction of N-50 and Nebraska Highway 1 (N-1) and extend north to the north end of viaduct over the BNSF Railroad (Structure Number S050-07611). The S-13F segment would start at the junction with N-50 and extend east to the corporate limits of Manley. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the current condition of the roadway.

Proposed improvements on this project would consist of milling and resurfacing the roadway and surfaced shoulders with asphalt, a bridge rehabilitation, and culvert work.

Improvements on S050-07611 would include guardrail, re-decking, girder modification, the remodeled barrier rail with railroad protection fence, new approaches with grade beams on piles, and wingwalls would be modified for the new approaches. Additional work would include abutment repairs and erosion repairs on the south bank.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE). If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to traffic phasing requirements.

Work would be required in the waterway. Wetland and/or other water resource impacts are anticipated; no mitigation would be required.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin as early as spring of 2026 and be completed as early as fall of 2027.

This project would be constructed primarily under traffic with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control devices and practices.

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system, and with your help, we can achieve this goal.

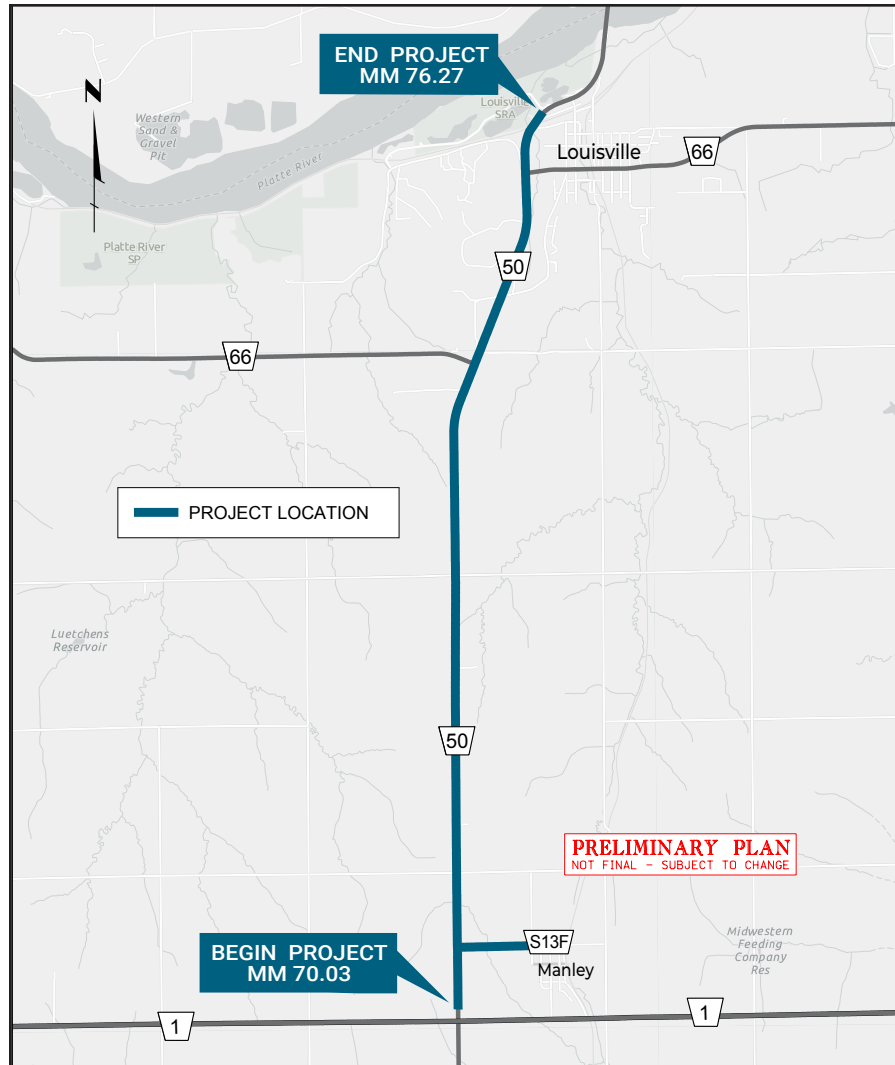
Projects in the Area

A separate project identified as **N-66 Connection in Louisville** [STP-66-7(119); C.N. 22795] is located within the proposed project vicinity. The proposed project is 1.27 miles in length and is located on Nebraska Highway 66 (N-66) starting at the intersection of N-66/N-50 and 5th Street at approximately mile marker (MM) 111.30 and extending east to the intersection of N-66 and Maple Street at approximately MM 111.85. The project would include the addition of an N-50 southbound left-turn lane and an N-50/N-66 northbound right-turn lane at the intersection with W 5th Street.

Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

A public information meeting is tentatively planned for spring of 2025 to provide information on the proposed project and to receive public input.
